UNDERTAKINGS

UNDERTAKINGS

- Members of ALL CDG Committees accept that they serve in several roles/capacities, principally as decision makers, directors and representatives of the individual members. Committee members undertake all duties and responsibilities with utmost honesty and integrity.
- Members of CDG Committees will when conducting business and events strive to implement management practices best suited to the individual situations and will ensure there is at all times an accountability for all these activities.
- Members of CDG Committees have implicit duties imposed on them which they need to act in accordance with:-
 - to be honest at all times with the use of their powers and in discharging their responsibilities.
 - to be appropriately caring and industrious at all times.
 - to be aware that at times they will be privy to information which they must not use to gain advantage for themselves or others and to be proper in their use of such information.
 - to never use their committee position to gain unfair advantage for themselves or others.

FOR CORE OFFICIALS (EVENT DIRECTORS, STEWARDS, GROUNDS PERSONS AND SCORERS)

UNDERTAKINGS

- Members of CDG who act in an official capacity as a Core Official undertake that they will act in accordance with the current EFA and FEI rules , CDG Constitution & By-Laws at all times
- Members of CDG who act in an official capacity as a Core Official, in recognition of the importance these capacities in the success and reputation of a CDG event, undertake to conduct themselves in a manner fitting & proper to those accorded the honor of officiating..
- Members of CDG who act in an official capacity as a Core Official, should strive to set exemplary standards in behavior by being polite and courteous, to know what is required of them in the context of their duty and its relation to the CDG event, to act with integrity at all times, to know the rules & regulations of the EFA & FEI or ensure they have access to such rules, to work co-operatively and respectfully with fellow Stewards, CDG members, Judges, Competitors and Volunteers and to support the efforts of the Committee.
